ICMPD would like to inform prospective applicants about the following updates in the abovementioned Call for Proposals.

Please see below the details of the changes in Call for Proposals documentation:

(1) Call for Proposal Guidelines (file: MMD III_1. Call for Proposals_Guidelines for Applicants_EN.pdf) has been updated.

The text of the Guidelines for Applicants has been modified as follows:

- Under the headline "Eligibility of Costs: costs that can be included", Section 2.4 of the Guidelines for Applicants, the following text has been deleted entirely:
 - "This includes equipment subject to depreciation as per ICMPD's accounting policies."
- Under the headline "Eligibility of Costs: costs that can be included", Section 2.4 of the Guidelines for Applicants, the following paragraph:
 - "Salary costs of the personnel may be eligible to the extent that they relate to the cost of activities that the grantee would not carry out if the action were not undertaken. Such costs need to be in line with the official remuneration policies of







the organization as well as in line with local legislation. The method for salary calculation should be clearly explained in the budget."

has been revised as:

"Salary costs of the personnel may be eligible to the extent that they relate to the cost of activities that the grantee would not carry out if the action were not undertaken. The total cost of human resources should not exceed the 30% of the total direct eligible costs. Such costs need to be in line with the official remuneration policies of the organization as well as in line with local legislation. The method for salary calculation should be clearly explained in the budget."
